

## Where to Find a Person's Cell Phone Number

Cell phone numbers are not like other phone numbers. They cannot be found in public listings such as phone books because they are protected by strict privacy laws. Until recently, cell phone number directories were only available to law enforcement and licensed investigators. The only way for an average person to obtain a cell phone number was to pay a private investigator up to \$200. While high, many people did consider the information worth the money.

Nowadays, privacy laws have become less strict. While cell phone numbers are still not public information, and therefore cannot be obtained for free, anyone can access cell phone number directories over the internet for a fee. This fee is much smaller than hiring a private investigator to access the same directories for the same information, and well worth it if the information is important.

The number of reputable, reliable sources with up to date information are relatively few, however. Where to find a cell phone number by name, and expect high quality results, then?
